Site Booking

Campers on Shell Island must book in at Reception on arrival before pitching tent. Campers may not be admitted after 9pm on Friday or 8pm on all other days. Online bookings now available.

Accounts

All fees payable on arrival, in advance with no refunds. Long stays must be paid for a week at a time in advance. Cards accepted Visa - MasterCard - Switch - Delta - Solo. ATM Cash Machine inside Snack Bar.

Sites

Sites must be vacated by 3.00 p.m. on day of departure. Campers not complying with this condition will be charged an extra night's fees and a full day ticket. Campers must leave their site tidy and free of all rubbish and stones. All rubbish to be taken to green skips conveniently located about the island.

Privacy

Campers may not pitch their tents within 20 yards/metres of another tent in the same field unless prior arrangement has been made with adjoining campers. Offenders are liable to be reported, when action will be taken to remedy the situation. The siting of tents should occupy the perimeter of the fields first. Centres of fields will only be used when the perimeters are fully occupied. Camping Pitches in the dune areas are as and where there are convenient pitches that afford some privacy to neighbouring campers.

Camp Fires

Campfires are not permitted on Shell Island, except on the beaches or **raised off the ground** in Fire Buckets **not on top of stones**. Smoke annoyance to other campers will not be tolerated. Barbecues are permitted. Disposable barbecues must be raised off the ground. Any one having campfires on the beach are responsible for clearing all rubbish away afterwards. Do not leave glass bottles and cans on the beaches/dunes.

Noise

No portable generators allowed. Radios and Televisions must have volume controls adjusted so as not to disturb other campers. Radios off by 11.00pm

Animals

Dogs must be kept under strict control and on leads at all times. Damage or annoyance will result in their owners being asked to leave the island. Dogs are not allowed in the Leisure complex buildings. Dog waste bins are situated around the Island - Doggy Bags are available free from the Toll Gate.

Toilets

The main toilets are situated in the central part of the Island. Satellite toilets are at the Green cabin and Portaloos around the site in Main Season. Please report immediately to the management any person thieving or doing wilful damage. Campers using elsan toilets are advised that they must be taken to the disposal point adjoining the toilet block.

Bikes

Campers using push bikes must wear crash helmets. Mini motor bikes are not allowed.

Showers

The shower block is situated behind and below the main toilet block. Showers are free and may only be used by campers and boat owners. Please report any day visitors using showers to reception.

Water Supply

Taps are conveniently situated in general next to gateways. Water taps are for filling water containers only. Washing under taps is strictly forbidden, washing-up area behind the shower block. Please report any water leakage - water is precious, and this could save your area from being cut off.

Speed Limit

A speed limit of 20 mph covers the whole of Shell Island. 10 mph near Toilets and central area.

Kites

All Power Kite owners must show insurance. They may only be flown 400yds/mtrs south of The Beach Car Park. Buggy kites by prior arrangement only.

Boat Owners

Boats and their equipment are at OWNERS RISK. No claim can be entertained by the management for personal injury, loss of life, theft, damage or total loss of boat. All boats on trailers must be registered with the Council prior to arrival. Insurance documents are required for all trailered boats. Trailers to be parked at owners camp. Speed limit 5 mph inside outer buoy.

Campers please note:

- FIREWORKS/CHINESE LANTERNS (Are not permitted)**
- Anyone caught letting off fireworks/chinese lanterns will be asked to leave.
- MOTORISED SCOOTERS, JET SKIS, QUADS, GO PEDS, MINI MOTORBIKES AND CARAVANS** are not allowed. Road legal bikes allowed as transport (subject to conditions), (Off road / Trial bikes are not allowed).
- CYCLISTS** must wear helmets while cycling on the Island.
- Normal road rules will apply, drink driving / speeding will be reported to the Police, who patrol the Site.
- No Smoking allowed inside any Shell Island Buildings.

10 RULES

- 1. Do not camp within 20 metres of another tent.**
- 2. Do not cut trees down.**
Shell Island is an area of Special Scientific Interest. Anyone reported or caught chopping trees down will be prosecuted and immediately be asked to leave.
- 3. Do not make open fires on fields.**
Do not make fires on the ground. **All fires must be raised off the ground in Fire bins, not on top of stones.**
Please ensure fire/ash is dampened before disposal into skips
Camp fires are O.K. on the beach - please clear up afterwards.
- 4. Do not leave rubbish around your site and always take rubbish to the nearest skip.**
Report untidy sites to Reception with relevant car numbers.
- 5. Always keep your dogs on leads at all times.**
There are a few fields where dogs are not allowed at anytime. Please look out for our relevant signs in these areas. Shell Island beach is one of the few beaches that dogs are allowed on, so please clean up after your dog, use the doggy bins. Free doggy bags are available from the Toll Gate.
- 6. All Power Kite owners must show insurance**
They may only be flown 400yds/mtrs south of The Beach Car Park.
Buggy kites by prior arrangement only.
- 7. No portable generators.**
Keep any music at a reasonable level. Radios must be turned off by 11.00pm
- 8. Tidy your site when you leave.**
Clear all litter away to skips. Put stones back on the walls.
- 9. Barbecues are allowed - but raise them off the grass.**
- 10. Break one of these Rules and you could be asked to leave the Site. Drive too fast or make too much noise and you will be asked to leave the Site.**

Gift Shop

Beach toys, Scoop Ice cream, Cut n' serve Fudge, Jewellery, etc etc.

Tavern Bar

Selling Beers Wines and Spirits for On and Off the premises – beers and wines at competitive prices.

Snack Bar

A wide menu available for consumption on the premises or as take outs.

Restaurant

Only open 12.30pm - 2.00pm on Sundays for Sunday Lunch - Bookings essential.

Emergencies

First Aid boxes are at Reception and the Gate/Security Hut. Any assistance that can be given will be given. All campers are advised to carry their own first aid box. If you require an emergency service, Doctor, Police, Ambulance, Coastguard, Fire Brigade, please inform either the Reception Office or Gate House staff on duty so that arrangements can be made for the service to come onto site via the Airfield in the event of the tide being up. 24 hr telephone available at entrance to Snack bar. Nearest Accident and Emergency Hospital - Bangor 1 Hour away. Fire boxes are provided within 200 metres of all sites. In the event of fire breaking out at your tent- raise the alarm, and get everyone out FIRST, then fetch a fire extinguisher from a fire box to fight the fire.

Conditions

Caravans/towable pods or jetski's are Not permitted on the island. Cars, landrovers or vans are not permitted to stay overnight unless their owners have a tent for sleeping purposes.
The entrance gates will be locked from 12.00 midnight until 8.00 am during the main season and a night watchman is available to open the gates in an emergency. Vehicles are not permitted to drive around the island after midnight or before 7.00 am. Emergencies or illness give exemption to this rule.
The practice of naturism is not permitted on Shell Island or on adjoining property. (An official beach some 2 miles to the South of Shell Island property does exist)
All campers accounts to be settled in advance. No refunds will be entertained. No arrivals after dark. Tents left without occupation and without notification for more than 4 days will be assumed to be abandoned and disposed of.

All fees payable on arrival in advance with no refunds, long stays must be paid for a week at a time.

No school parties or large groups during Whitsun weekend and July 10th to September 1st.

Children rates apply to children aged 3 - 15 years.

OAP rates may apply during off peak periods.

Shell Island is a Families and Couples Campsite. We do not accept Single Sex groups or Youngsters camping by themselves without parental supervision.
